Declaration of Conformity to California Proposition 65

Proposition 65 (Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986) is a Californian law that requires businesses to notify Californians about significant chemicals that cause cancer or birth defects or other reproductive harm. Moreover, our products consist of integrated circuits and related semiconductor devices, which are not consumer products available for retail sale, and which do not expose humans to any carcinogens or reproductive toxins through inhalation or absorption through the skin in their final configuration.

Though if a customer is using the product outside of normal operating practices or if performing a destructive component test, the application is done at a customer's own risk. To reduce the risk of exposure, we recommend use of approved safety equipment including, face masks, filters and gloves designed specifically for the purpose of filtering out particles.
