RE: Materials from Conflict Regions



While we continually take actions such as substitution and elimination of materials that pose environmental, health or safety risk, we fully comply with all legislations regarding material restrictions in countries where our products are sold or where we sourced our raw materials.

In fact, when sourcing and procuring raw materials, Everspin exercises complete due diligence. We require our suppliers to provide us guarantee letters and if necessary critical information attesting that they do not source their metals mined from the Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC) and/or adjoining countries controlled by unlawful, non-government military factions. We are very much aware that illegal mining being carried out in this so-called "conflict region" contributes to human rights abuses and environmental degradation.

Rest assured Everspin will maintain its excellent business ethics and pursue its corporate social responsibility at all times.
